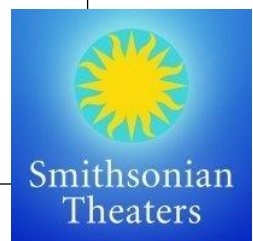

2016 Aviation Education and Career EXPO Scholarship Application

1. Print your name on the top of the Scholarship Choices list.
2. Check the boxes on the Scholarship Choices list to indicate your interests.
3. Write your essay following the guidelines below. If you wish to apply for both tuition scholarships and Flight Training Ground School scholarships, you must submit a separate essay.
4. Fill out the cover sheet application that includes your name, contact information and name of the essay.
5. **SUBMIT COMPLETED APPLICATION with Scholarship choices, cover page, and your essay TO expo@projetaviation.com NO LATER THAN October 7, 2016.**

Essay question # 1: For tuition and monetary awards. *If you could fly on any aircraft to any destination – What would it be? Where would you go? Who would you take? (up to 1000 words)*

Essay question # 2: For Ground School Scholarships. *What are the benefits of a ground school scholarship? How would you use that scholarship to pursue your dreams of becoming a pilot? (up to 500 words)*

The following criteria will be used to judge your essay.

1. **Comprehension** 25 points How well does the essay respond to the question?
2. **Organization** 25 points Does the essay follow a logical and easily understood progression? Are the main points supported by evidence and examples?
3. **Content & Creativity** 25 points How compelling is your story?
4. **Writing** 25 points Correct grammar, spelling, punctuation and use of language.

Submission Guidelines Double space the essay, using 12 point font. Your submission must be in essay form which uses complete sentences; this is not Twitter or a text message.

1. Each essay must reflect the contestant's own research, writing and original thoughts.
2. Essays must be typed and submitted via email in a word document. The scholarship selection form and the applicant cover page must be submitted with the essay.
3. The title of the essay, but NOT the author's name, MUST appear on the top of the first page of essay text.
4. References used in the essay should be clearly identified.
