Hello Fairfield Families!

I hope this letter finds you well and that you have all been enjoying your summer. This letter pertains all things Counseling Office related. Yes it IS LONG but the information is important. I have tried to break it into sections so you can pick and choose what may apply to your family.

Scheduling:

- Student schedules are available to view in Skyward, if you require a schedule change, please have your student complete the Google form (posted in Schoology), I realize I am working through them slower than anticipated, but rest assured, if the form is completed I will get to you in the order that it is received. Duplicate entries and follow up emails are not necessary if the form is completed.
- Independent Study in Art will not be available this year
- Gaps are not permitted in schedules
- Online Courses: If you requested an online course it will not appear on your schedule until closer
 to the term that you registered to take it. As long as you filled out the online course request form
 you are good to go.
- Conflict: If you see "conflict" listed on your schedule, it is most likely in block 2 or 3. If it is in block 2, it is because we have courses that run the entire block, and courses that run half of the block. If you have a course listed in "2" you will see conflicts in 2A and 2B, if you have a course listed in 2A or 2B you will see a conflict in block "2". If you have a 2A course, make sure you also have a 2B and vice versa. So you must have either a block "2" or a 2A AND 2B. Ignore "conflict" in block 3 unless you for some reason have two courses listed during the same block at the same time.
- Course load make sure your courses are scheduled in sequence (Geometry then Algebra II, Intro to Art then Art 3D, PreCalculus then Calculus, Spanish I before Spanish II etc) Also make sure your course load is evenly distributed. You do not want to be taking all of your core courses in one semester, if it can be helped. If you are unsure about sequencing please check the informational sheet I posted on the Counseling Website under Scheduling or check the Course Selection Book listed under scheduling on the website.
- PE You MUST have a PE every year, even if you doubled up somewhere
- Personal Finance is NOT a Math course and IS a graduation requirement

Communications:

- Schoology is the main method of communication from the Counseling Office to students, please
 make sure your student checks the Counseling Group (Class of 202_Counseling Group)
 regularly.
- If information is for parents and students, it is sent through Skyward, which sends it to the student's school email, and the email address the parent has on file with the district (please check your spam folders)
- First line of contact for communication and things occurring in a classroom is the teacher of the
 class. If you contact the office or Counseling Office regarding a teacher/class the first question
 you will be asked is "have you spoken with the teacher?" and if you have not, you will be
 directed to contact the teacher. All concerns and communications MUST go through the teacher
 first.

Incoming Seniors:

- Information has been posted in Schoology regarding Transcript Audits and Senior Meetings.
 These are mandatory for graduation, and parents can attend if they/you would like. Transcripts for the audit can be found in Schoology under Portfolio, please use the Final transcript from June 2022

Testing:

- Information regarding PSAT, SAT and ACT for fall has been posted in Schoology (and was also sent home via Skyward)
- Sign up dates are firm and payment is due at time of registration
- If payment is not received your test could be canceled

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- Juniors and PSAT all Juniors are automatically registered to take the PSAT paid for by the district. If you do NOT want to take the PSAT you MUST OPT OUT by September 12th using the above QR codes or link in Schoology.
