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FAQs

As we move forward with the remainder of the school year and the changes that have occurred, we are providing information and updates. We do not have the answers for some questions at this time, but we will continue to keep you informed as we receive information from the Governor and the Secretary of Education.

1. Now that grading has ended, does instruction end?
 - a. No, teachers will continue to provide learning opportunities on a week-by-week basis. Teachers will continue to give feedback to the students after reviewing the submitted assignments.
2. Will there be contact from the teachers to my child?
 - a. Yes, teachers will continue to communicate with students and parents about instruction, questions, concerns, and participation.
 - b. The district is allowing teachers to utilize "Zoom" meetings for contact with their students. It is not mandatory for students to participate, but the opportunity to have a face-to-face meeting is an option available for all teachers.
3. What are my child's expectations for the remainder of the year?
 - a. The expectation is for your child to continue to participate in the educational process. Your child should complete the assignments to the best of his/her ability.
 - b. Your child should submit questions, comments or concerns to his/her teacher(s).
4. Grading has now ended for most students for the 4th marking period. Are there any consequences if my child does not complete the work?
 - a. If having consequences equates to failing or not moving ahead to the next grade, then no. If consequences equates to not taking advantage of the learning opportunities to be best prepared for the next grade level or course sequence, they may find themselves not prepared if they do not complete the assignments.
5. If a student was expecting to complete a Spring Keystone, will they be required to take it next year?
 - a. At this time, we do not have an answer to that question. All districts are waiting on guidance from the Department of Education.





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6. My child has personal items at the school and we have items that need to be returned to the school. How will we retrieve our items and return the school district's property (textbooks, library books, borrowed instruments, choral robes and folders, athletic uniforms)?
 - a. The district has developed a plan for retrieving and returning the items on Monday, April 27th (11:30 a.m. – 6:30 p.m.) and Tuesday, April 28th (7:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.).
 - i. Please stay in your vehicle and a staff member will greet you. The staff member will radio inside the building to have your child's item(s) brought to you while you remain in your vehicle.
 - ii. If you have anything to be returned, the staff member will collect the items.
 - b. Any medication that remains in the district may be picked up at your child's designated school during the above-noted date and times.
 - c. Elementary students' items may be retrieved at the main entrance of the elementary school
 - d. Middle school students' items may be retrieved in the parking lot that is located on the east side of the MS/HS building. The staff member will be at the first set of glass doors (marked exit 10).
 - e. High school students' items may be retrieved on the backside of the MS/HS building by the cafeteria dock at the glass doors (marked exit 19).

7. Will the district continue to distribute lunch? If so, when will lunches be distributed?
 - a. Lunches will be distributed to any student of the district on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday of each week.
 - b. Lunch distribution is available 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the MS/HS entrance.
