- Hot dogs

ITEMS ANIMALS NEED IN SHELTER:

- Toys (cat/dog)
- Leashes and collars
- Brushes/grooming tools
- Pet beds
- Water and food bowls

OTHER ITEMS: Pet supplies aren't the only supplies shelters need. Some other things that come in handy for shelters include
