STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES

- The Board believes that an important ingredient of a democratic society is the willingness of citizens to participate in community service organizations and to serve on local political organizations. The Board further believes the District should set an example of encouraging early interest and commitment to active community involvement in the school's student body.
- Two student representatives to the Board are authorized to work constructively with the members of the Board and Superintendent in the development of policy statements which specify what the schools should try to accomplish and participate in policy evaluation to determine how effectively they are executed.
- 1480.3 The student representatives shall meet qualifications, and be selected in accordance with guidelines, as developed by the Superintendent.
- Once selected, the representatives shall have responsibilities, as do all Board members, that must be met in a continuously devoted manner. These requirements shall be developed by the Superintendent and revised as necessary.
- 1480.5 A junior class representative shall be elected/appointed annually for a two-year period from September May of their senior year. When possible, the representatives should be from different grades.
- 1480.6 Appointments, if made, shall be based upon administrative recommendation.
- 1480.7 The Board and student representatives will maintain official interaction only on matters concerned with policy development and agenda items.
