1660.1 <u>Majority Vote Required</u>

"The affirmative vote of a majority of all the members of the board of school directors in every school district, duly recorded showing how each member voted, shall be required in order to take action on the following subjects:

Fixing the length of school term.

Adopting textbooks.

Appointing or dismissing district superintendents, principals, and teachers.

Appointing tax collectors and other appointees.

Adopting the annual budget.

Levying and assessing taxes.

Purchasing, selling, or condemning land.

Locating new buildings or changing the location of old ones.

Dismissing a teacher after a hearing.

Creating or increasing any indebtedness.

Adopting courses of study.

Establishing additional schools or departments.

Designating depositories for school funds.

Entering into contracts of any kind, including contracts for the purchase of fuel or any supplies, where the amount involved exceeds one hundred (\$100) dollars.

Fixing salaries or compensation of officers, teachers, or other appointees of the Board of School Directors.

Entering into contracts with and making appropriations to the intermediate unit for the district's proportionate share of the cost of services provided or to be provided for by the intermediate unit..." [Sec. 508]

1660.2 Noncompliance

"Failure to comply with the provisions of this section shall render such acts of the board of school directors void and unenforceable." [Sec. 508]

1660.3 <u>Transfers</u>

"...(d) The board of school directors shall have power to authorize the transfer of any unencumbered balance, or any portion thereof, from one class of expenditure or item, to another, but such action shall be taken only during the last nine (9) months of the fiscal year..." [Sec. 687(2)]

1660.4 Two-thirds Majority Vote Required

The affirmative vote of a two-thirds majority of the members of the Board, duly recorded showing how each member voted, shall be required in order to take action on the following subjects:

Borrowing in anticipation of current revenues [Sec. 640]

Temporary loans [Sec. 687(c)]

Selling or giving land to the community college [Sec. 707(611)]

Dealing with temporary debts [Sec. 634]

Overriding a Superintendent's recommendation regarding textbook selection [Sec. 803]
