EMERGENCY PLANS

2720.1 <u>Priority</u> During any emergency, the first and foremost priority is the <u>safety</u> of students and staff members.

As conditions permit, priorities will include the protection of property within the school.

2720.2 <u>Procedures</u> **Remember to stay calm**. This will go a long way in managing the emergency situation and in reassuring students and staff.

2720.3 <u>Reporting</u> Contact appropriate individuals/agencies

The designated individual will contact the emergency service (police, fire or ambulance) **promptly by dialing 911**. The following information is to be provided:

- 1. Location (name of school, address and municipality).
- 2. Type of emergency (fire, medical, etc.).
- 3. Brief description of the emergency.
- 4. Your name.
- 5. Telephone number from which you are calling.
- 6. **Do not hang up until the 911 operator tells you to do so.**

Contact the principal who in turn will contact the Superintendent, following specific details as outlined in the Emergency Operations Plan provided to each staff member.
