## GENERAL EMPLOYMENT CONDITIONS

- 3310.1 The Board fully realizes the importance of equitable and attractive working conditions. Policies regarding employment conditions are constantly reviewed and revised with the objectives being the attraction and retention of competent teachers. It is further realized that by improving working conditions under which professional educators render service, all members of the staff are more inclined to make greater contributions to the total program.
- In the best interests of all concerned, curricular and extracurricular duties shall be assigned as far as is possible to those staff members who have appropriate interests, training, and competencies in those fields.
- 3310.3 Teaching load in terms of class size shall be arranged with regard to that which is most conducive to learning and that which can meet budgetary requirements.
