- 5115.1 The Board subscribes to an instructional program and such courses of study that will provide academic preparations for students to help them become competent individuals who will be prepared to assume a role in shaping the future.
- Although the commitment is to an all-inclusive educational program, there shall also be attention given to basic training in desirable moral and ethical behavior.
- 5115.3 The Board recognizes that all children can learn, and do so at different rates. Opportunities shall be offered allowing each child to pursue educational qualifications to meet his needs and desires.
- 5115.4 The curriculum offerings shall be in such quantity and quality so as to afford the balance that a child may wish to have in the pattern of instruction that he chooses.
- 5115.5 The Board accepts the premise that the school curriculum must be tailored to the child and that the instructional program shall be designed to be developmentally appropriate.
- Therefore, the District shall offer a comprehensive program which shall take into consideration the needs of the students with strong ties with the parents and community programs.
