EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

- All schools shall be subject to periodic evaluation through faculty selfevaluation by the Department of Education and/or by the Middle States Association of Colleges and State Secretary of Education.
- There shall be a constant evaluation of the grading policy of the school system. The rules and regulations which prevail shall be examined periodically by the teachers and administrators for possible revisions. Until revisions are made, the grading policy in effect shall prevail.
- 5420.3 Constant evaluation of courses of study shall be made to determine their relevancy to the needs of the pupils.
- 5420.4 Approved testing procedures shall be employed as determined by the Faculty and Guidance Department and approved by the administration.
