

- 5460.1 Travel-study programs are sponsored by school-related organizations and need not be curriculum related but should be directly related to the purpose of the organization.
- 5460.2 Travel-study programs are permitted only under certain circumstances and every effort should be made to schedule the trip on days when school is not in session.
- 5460.3 Travel-study programs may include no more than one school day for travel and/or touring places of educational interest.
- 5460.4 Travel-study programs must have approval of the Building Principal and the Superintendent.
- 5460.5 All overnight and out-of-state, travel-study programs must have the approval of the building principal, the Superintendent, and the Board.
- 5460.6 Students participating in travel-study programs are required to turn in a permission slip signed by a parent or guardian. No student shall be permitted to make the trip without having a signed permission slip.
- 5460.7 Students violating school regulations will be handled according to school policies and procedures.
- 5460.8 At least one teacher must accompany all programs.
- 5460.9 There must be at least one adult per bus (maximum of five (5) per bus).
- 5460.10 Overnight trips require at least one adult for every fifteen (15) students.
