Terrorist Threats and Acts

6495

- 6495.1 Under the direction of the Superintendent, the district administrators shall implement the following procedures when a student communicates or commits terroristic threats and acts.
- 6495.1a The student will be removed from the student population. The student will not be left alone.
  - 6495.2a The principal or designee will investigate the evidence that a student has committed or communicated terroristic threat or act.
  - 6495.3a The principal or designee will contact the parent/guardian immediately and describe the situation. The principal or designee will attempt to provide parent/guardian with an opportunity to be present when police are involved.
  - 6495.4a Confidentiality-Confined to those with a need to know as mandated by school policy.
  - 6495.5a The Principal or designee will investigate the student's background and make findings known to those with a need to know. Refer to TARGETS Team.
  - 6495.6a Suspension from school for up to ten (10) days, suspension from all school related extra-curricular activities for one calendar year
  - 6495.7a A recommendation will be made to the Board for an expulsion hearing.
  - 6495.8a Law enforcement agency will be notified.
- 6495.2 In the case of exceptional students, the district will take all steps necessary to comply with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and follow Board policy.
