- By law, teachers are responsible for their students' conduct to and from school. Therefore, the following regulations shall be enforced:
  - 6415.1a All students shall come directly to school and return to their home without loitering on the school grounds or streets. Pupils who participate in scheduled after-school activities shall go directly home following the close of the activity unless other permission is granted.
  - 6415.1b Conduct enroute to and from school and home shall be such that it does not reflect adversely upon the school or their parents.
  - 6415.1c If circumstances make it necessary to deviate from these rules, a note from the parent or guardian explaining the reason must be sent to the teacher.
- During inclement weather admission to school may be earlier at the discretion of the Principal.
