- 6180.1 Individual must be taking a minimum of three one credit courses at Fairfield during senior year.
- 6180.2 All courses in grades 9 through 12 will be counted toward grade point average, regardless of school attended. The valedictorian and salutatorian must attend Fairfield High School for the last 90 school days during senior year.
- 6180.3 College courses submitted to the Fairfield Guidance Office to be counted as part of student's record, will be counted in grade point average on basis of one three credit course equal to .5 Carnegie Unit.
- 6180.4 College course taken during school year while attending Fairfield will be counted in G.P.A. if the course (counted for credit at Fairfield).
- 6180.5 Foreign exchange students will not be granted a diploma from Fairfield Area School District. They will receive a certificate of attendance. It is recommended that foreign exchange students attend during their junior year.
- 6180.6 Courses taken during the summer to improve a grade for a course previously taken at Fairfield will be averaged with grade received at Fairfield. Both courses will be reflected on transcript although only averaged grade will be used for G.P.A.
- 6180.7 Students attending college, while also students at Fairfield, will be eligible to graduate with high honors and honors.
