Chemicals

The Fairfield Area School District's policy concerning the purchase, storage, identification and disposition of hazardous chemicals meets the requirements as stated in the Pennsylvania Worker and Community Right to Know Law, Act 1984-159. All chemicals acquired for school science laboratories must: (1) have material safety data sheets available, (2) be purchased in small quantities to minimize amounts stored from year to year, (3) be disposed of according to Environmental Protection Agency guidelines, and (4) be stored according to chemical families and in appropriate facilities. The District will conduct annual training for employees who handle or are exposed to these chemicals.

For any chemicals stored in areas of the District other than science laboratories, the District will comply with all requirements of Act 1984-159.
