STUDENT DISCIPLINE ON SCHOOL BUSES

- 7630.1 The students are the first and prime responsibility of the driver, with safety as the main concern.
 - 7630.1a The administration of the various schools shall include in their student handbooks rules and regulations for riders of buses.
 - 7630.1b Students are to be instructed in their classroom of the needs for observance of all safety rules and bus regulations.
 - 7630.1c Drivers are not to refuse bus privileges or order students from the bus since such action is administrative only.
- 7630.2 In case of misconduct by students, forms are provided for reporting such action.
 - 7630.2a Reports of misconduct are to be given to the appropriate Building Level Principal on the day of occurrence.
 - 7630.2b The appropriate Building Level Principal and/or the Superintendent shall decide upon further action dependent upon the seriousness of the misconduct report.
 - 7630.2c Extreme cases of misconduct may involve exclusion of school transportation privileges for a period of time.
 - 7630.2d Permanent exclusion can result from extremely serious or repeated misbehavior, with the student's parent being notified.
