BUS EVACUATION DRILLS

7650

- 7650.1 Evacuation drills will be held two (2) times per school year, September and March, according to law and regulations.
- 7650.2 Public bus routes will conduct evacuations on school property and will be assisted by Fairfield Area School District transportation personnel or administration.
- 7650.3 Nonpublic bus routes will conduct evacuations at an area determined by the transportation department as a safe area and be assisted by Fairfield Area School District transportation personnel or administration.
- 7650.4 All bus students present at the time of the drill must participate, unless previous arrangements are made in writing by the parent/legal guardian with the transportation office.
- 7650.5 Students are advised on procedures implemented in the event that the driver is unable to assist during an emergency. The student is instructed:
- a) How to shut the engine off.
 - b) Where emergency phone numbers are.
 - c) Where all emergency equipment is kept.
 - d) How to use cellular phones to call for help.
 - e) During an evacuation they must stay together and travel to a safe distance away from the bus.
