BUS TRANSPORTATION ELIGIBILITY/CHANGES

7660

- 7660.1 It is the intent of the Fairfield Area School District to provide safe, efficient, and orderly transportation for the students that are legal residents of the District and properly enrolled at Fairfield.
- 7660.2 PA School Code Section 2541:
Elementary students (K-6) that reside beyond one and one-half (1 1/2) miles of their assigned school building or reside on a certified hazardous route are eligible to be transported by the District.

Secondary students (7-12) that reside beyond two (2) miles of their assigned school building or reside on a certified hazardous route are eligible to be transported by the District.
- 7660.3 Nonpublic students, who legally reside in the District, and are within the provisions of Act 372 and current state law and regulations are eligible to be transported by the District.
- 7660.4 Denial of Transportation
Transportation may be denied per administrative decision:
a) For bus conduct infractions.
b) For recurring situations caused by parent/guardian/sitter that jeopardize the safety or efficiency of the transportation department, after written notice to the parent of said student.
- 7660.5 All public students will be assigned to route and stop area, using information provided to the Transportation Coordinator at the end of the previous school year.
- 7660.6 During the school year, requests for bus transportation must be made by submitting a completed a Transportation Form two (2) school days prior to beginning date of transportation.
- 7660.7 Requests for alternate bus stops requiring a bus change will be approved upon availability of space on the alternate bus and if the alternate route has allotted time.
- 7660.8 A request for a change from the assigned bus stop for a reason of health shall be substantiated by documentation from a physician.

- 7660.9 Bus stop changes on an assigned bus will be accepted on a limited basis provided stop requested is an established stop.
- 7660.10 Transportation will be limited to a maximum of two (2) locations for pick-up and two (2) locations for drop-off. The daily schedule must be consistent for the week.
- 7660.11 Permanent changes in bus and bus stop locations for child care arrangements and/or extracurricular activities are limited to three (3) times a school year per student. Changes to legal residence shall be accommodated without limit.
