- In compliance with the state retirement law, the Board shall deduct such percentage as provided by the Retirement Board from the full amount of each warrant issued to any full-time school employee. Money deducted from pay warrants is transmitted monthly by the District as directed by the Public School Retirement Board. All employees entering school service are required to become members of the State School Retirement Plan, provided they are full-time employees.
- In compliance with federal income tax laws, deductions shall be made from each salary warrant in amount prescribed by law. The federal government supplies income tax tables for the purpose of computing withholding tax according to information furnished by each employee on Form W-4, U. S. Treasury, Internal Revenue Service.
- Deductions shall be made for local wages which are levied by the District or by any of the municipalities within the Fairfield Area School District whenever these taxes apply to an employee.
- The following deductions may be made by the Board with the authorization of the employee health Insurance; and dues to employee groups that are recognized as official bargaining units by the Pennsylvania Labor Relations Board.
