TITLE: INTERVENTION SPECIALIST

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Intervention Specialist is responsible for providing remedial math and reading services within his/her assigned buildings and acting as a resource to the staff within those buildings. Terms of employment are established by contract between the Board of School Directors and the Fairfield Education Association.

QUALIFICATIONS:

 Holds a diploma from a college or other institution approved by the Department of Education.

Pennsylvania certification in the area of Reading Specialist is required.

REPORTS TO: Building Principal

EVALUATION: Evaluations will be conducted in accordance with district policy.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

 Identifies students needing diagnosis, correction and remediation of mathematics and/or reading problems.

 Provides remedial math and/or reading instruction to those students having the most severe amount of reading problems.

• Identifies students who might profit from the services of other school professionals.

• Establishes a schedule of classes in cooperation with classroom teachers and building principals.

Maintains information on each child receiving intervention services.

Shares materials and techniques with Classroom Teachers.

 Performs any other reading instruction tasks as may be required by the Building Principal.
