- Gym Pennants and Banners- The gym pennants and banners are in the process of being updated. Joe Marcharsky has not provided the cost yet. Deedee will contact Joe to get prices.
- Concessions/Pippenfest money distribution- The monies earned working concessions is based on a formula, FAST gets 80% and the team working gets 20%, (minimum payout is \$50.00). Sherry stated that the profit earned working Pippenfest parking for teams far
