What is the problem and how is it resolved or not resolved?</li> <li>❖ Write a 3-4 paragraph letter to the author arguing for a different ending</li> <li>❖ Create a comic strip including the major characters, the conflict, and the climax. Include a 3-5 sentence explanation of the comic.</li> <li>❖ Identify a major theme in the book. In 2 paragraphs, explain the theme's message, using at least one direct example from the text.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Move the story to a different time period (the past or future). Rewrite one paragraph from the book in this new time period. In another paragraph, explain how this change might affect the story.</li> <li>❖ Draw and label a place where an important event occurs in the book with a 3-5 sentence summary of the event.</li> <li>❖ Create a Venn diagram of the setting of the book and your own neighborhood. Include five qualities of each neighborhood in bullet point form.
