TREASURER'S REPORT

ACTION ITEMS

- **Chicken BBQ:** Deedee reported that the chicken BBQ was a success. Ninety meals were sold, and everyone agreed to host another one next season.
- **Spirit wear:** Sherry gave an update on the Spirit wear sales.
- **Concession Stand update:**
There have not been enough volunteers to open or close the concession stand. Lisa L. is having to stay and open because of new volunteers not knowing the proper procedure. She suggests that the in 2019 we split up the opening day duties between the FAST officers. Everyone agreed to this.
- **Pippenfest parking update:** Profits from parking this year doubled from the last three years due to limited parking in downtown Fairfield (due to the extremely wet weather).
- **Donations:** Lisa Koons is still working on the donation from the Blue Ridge Sportsman's Club. She will give us an update at the November 14th meeting. We will also try to solicit a donation from the AMVETS in Fairfield.
- **District Tee-shirts:** All the Fairfield athletes that made districts will get a custom tee-shirt provided by FAST.

OPEN DISCUSSION

- **Winter Concessions sign-ups:** Scheduled for November 14, 2018. The Coaches will be notified of the date. Lisa Koons informed everyone that the indoor concessions stand has been cleaned and stocked and is ready to go.
- **Knight Mascot purchase:** The Knight's mascot costume had to be thrown out because of the mold remediation. Deedee proposed that FAST buy the school a new costume and showed some examples to the group. Everyone agreed that it was a great idea and approved the purchase of the new costume.
